

**TOWN OF GREEN BAY, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN**  
**MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING**

Chairman Lee Dechamps called the annual town meeting to order at 7:00 pm and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Review last year's minutes**

John Metzler made a motion to accept the minutes as read by Clerk with a second by Pete Mathu. 10-Yes 0-No Motion Carried.

Review Financial Statements – Town & Fire Dept.

Dawn Goodman stated there was a newspaper article regarding delinquent property taxes and the Town of Green Bay was listed as 10% delinquent status - Treasurer, Jadin explained the Town does not collect delinquent property taxes, the County handles delinquent real estate taxes and the Town collects the delinquent personal property taxes. Interest is calculated on all outstanding taxes. Currently there are foreclosure listings in the Town of Green Bay, this includes some of the Edgewater Bluff Condo Properties.

Motion made by Bob Geyer to accept the Town of Green Bay annual report as read by Treasurer Jadin with a second by John Metzler. 10-Yes 0-No Motion Carried.

John Metzler made a motion to accept the Fire Department financial report for 2006 with a second by Dan Paye. 10-Yes 0-No Motion Carried.

**Bridge Fund for 2007 Taxes**

Dawn Goodman questioned an estimate cost of a new bridge. The Board explained the bridge project completed on Gauthier Road in 2006 was completed at a cost of approximately \$87,000 and that was with a large culvert placement. If a bridge was to be constructed it would be approx. \$100,000.

Jim Roberts questioned the number of bridges in the town and the inspection process. Chairman explained the Town has nine bridges and currently the County handles the bridge inspections. Bob Geyer made a motion to appropriate \$20,000 to the 2007 Bridge Fund with a second by John Metzler. 10-Yes 0-No Motion Carried.

**Any other business presented by the Electors**

The Chairman gave the floor to the electors.

Mr. Prevost questioned if the Town of Green Bay would be willing to sell parcel GB-361 and if hazardous material testing would be required. He stated he would be willing to pay for the testing.

Further Discussion was held. The Board stated this would have to be further researched and tabled for a future meeting if desired by Mr. Prevost.

Discussion held regarding a possible future sex offender ordinance.

Chairman explained Meade & Hunt will be at the Thursday, April 12, 2007 regular meeting to discuss the Mercier Road project.

Chairman Dechamps also gave updates on the following:

There will be financing in the near future to purchase a fire truck and for future road repairs.

The Town has joined the Multi-Jurisdictional Municipal Court system to aid in ordinance enforcement.

The retaining wall on Edgewater Beach Road has been repaired, as well as the Bridge on Gauthier Road.

Discussion held regarding the future funding for road repair.

Pete Mathu made a motion to appropriate \$160,000 for road improvements for the 2008 budget. Second by Bob Geyer. 10-Yes 0-No Motion Carried.
