

**MINUTES OF MEETING

It is noted the meeting was properly posted.

1. Call to Order

Chairman Bosman called the meeting to order at 7 pm and meeting was opened by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Review and take Action on February meeting minutes

Motion made by Sup Pribyl to accept February 10th minutes as presented. Second by Chairman Bosman 2 Ayes 0 Nays. Motion Carried

3. Review Planning Commission minutes - there was no meeting held

4. Review Board of Appeals minutes – there was no meeting held

5. Review Zoning Administrator Report and Building Inspector Report

Motion made by Chairman Bosman to accept the Building Inspector Report and Zoning Administrator Report for February, 2026. Second by Sup Pribyl. 2 Ayes 0 Nays. Motion Carried

6. Old Business

A. Update, Discontinuing Portion of Bay Shore Park Access Road Right of Way (Resolution 2026-1)

Clerk stated she had contacted the town's attorney, and he reviewed the paperwork she had drafted and agreed with the drafted Resolution and publishing. Clerk stated Brown County and Rabas' are where the letters were sent.

7. Constable Report

It was stated the Board will get a report from the Humane Society monthly.

Constable stated he had received a call about a dog; he brought it to the Humane Society. Constable confirmed, he will pick up dogs only, board agreed.

8. Correspondence Received

A. Bridge Inspections

Chairman Bosman said we spoke about bridge inspections at the last meeting, Ayres had contacted us, stated we had one bridge inspection due. They sent us a proposal. Bridge B-05-0276 \$1,060 fee to inspect the bridge. Chairman Bosman stated they maintain our records and have done it in the past. Sup Pribyl made a motion to have Ayres complete the bridge inspection. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried

B. County Rescue

Chairman Bosman updated, stated they have been having meetings with County Rescue which is our EMS provider. He further stated, the First Responder, Jim Andrews, he responds quickly, he provides first aid and comfort and gets the information. He further stated, our ambulance comes from Bellevue or Denmark whichever is closer, Green Bay is taking

away some of their inner-city units, he explained there is a house near the Fire Dept, it had been leased on a 1 year contract which comes due in May. County Rescue would like to lease it out and would park in the Fire Dept. 2 cameras on the front of the house and 2 cameras on the squad, County Rescue's presence would take our response time from 27-31 minutes down to 7 or 8 minutes. He explained the most qualified is a paramedic, we will always have a paramedic and an EMT on call, sometimes there may be 2 paramedics staffed there. A contract was signed in 2021 for \$15 per capita. For Town of Scott, Town of Humboldt, and Town of Green Bay. It is the same unit that New Franken Fire, will stay with. In 2027 we will be signing a new contract with them and either way we will see an increase to \$45/per capita. Asst Fire Chief in New Franken who is also a full-time Captain in Oshkosh, they pay \$53 /per capita. A couple of other places the commission checked were over \$50/per capita. Discussion held, it was stated this will be a gradual increase. Chairman stated, the house was rented for \$1,450, we will be charging County Rescue \$1,850, but we will be doing the snowplowing and grass cutting and will make the yard smaller and manageable. The land and house are owned by the 3 towns. 1/3, 1/3, 1/3, the contract will get written up. Tonight, they are looking for a motion to approve to rent the house. Chairman further explained the Fire Dept. sub committee is looking at putting an addition on New Franken Fire Dept. approximately \$5.6 million currently in the early stages, it would have to go to a referendum, the commission toured BUG fire dept. Door County owns their EMS, they paid for 1/3 of that building. The planning is in the infant stages. He stated Sup DeBroux is Fire Chief, each of the meetings will have to be during the day. Sup Pribyl made a motion to go forward with County Rescue to rent the house which is owned by the three towns. Second by Chairman Bosman. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried The Board stated they are good with the increase to \$45/per capita. It was stated the service is good and will only get better.

Clerk stated she had received an email from Bay Care Clinic, they have an event on June 6th The board stated there should be no road work in the town that will effect their ride. Board stated regarding a Fire Report, Insurance was increased, Sup Pribyl stated at the last meeting, they spoke of increase to the coverage, he talked about a town hall which was just built was a million. Clerk stated she had a virtual meeting with DNR which was required by the DNR; they stated we will have to amend our current Recycling Ordinance. Clerk gave update on town hall title, Clerk to check with LC School Dist and Wis Historical Society. Discussion held regarding a part who sprays wild parsnip, Zachary Firebaun, he has a 500 gallon sprayer with a one-sided fold out boom, \$235/lane mile. Something to think about. Chairman Bosman will hold on to his number. Zoning Administrator, Jason stated he received a call after meeting in February, he spoke with resident complaint about someone parking their truck on Tielens Rd. Jason spoke with someone who is moving a garage onto a property. Further discussion held regarding complains on Edgewater Beach Rd and Stone Pillar Rd.

9. Any other Business Authorized by Law

A. Open floor for public comment

Motion to open the floor made by Sup Pribyl. Second by Chairman Bosman. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried
Dawn Goodman stated she saw on Channel 2 news, a town in Silver Cliff lost their insurance because of storms.
Discussion held. Motion to close the floor by Chairman Bosman. Second by Sup Pribyl. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried

10. Clerk and Treasurer Reports

Chairman stated the Treasurer report will be tabled until April. Chairman requested moving forward, since there are vacations, if any Board member knows they will be gone, if they could have reports and any information necessary given in advance. Chairman Bosman made a motion to accept the Clerk's report and table the treasurer report until April 21st meeting. Second by Sup Pribyl. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried

11. Review Vouchers and Pay Bills

Motion made by Chairman Bosman to review the vouchers and pay the bills. Second by Sup Pribyl. 2 Ayes 0 Nays Motion Carried

12. Next Meeting Dates/Adjourn

Audit Meeting scheduled for March 24th at 6 pm.

April meeting is April, 21st at 7 pm. Annual meeting and Regular meeting. Chairman Bosman asked that any bills due should be paid timely and vouchers reviewed at meeting. Sup Pribyl agreed. Motion made to adjourn by Sup Pribyl. Second by Chairman Bosman. Meeting adjourned at 9:10 pm.
